

Bee Happy Sew Along -- Week 3: **Mason Jars and Bluebirds**

Cut Background: 8 1/2" x 16 1/2" (no trimming afterwards)

	<b>Jar A Jam Jar</b>	<b>Jar B Heart Jar</b>	<b>Jar C Honey</b>	<b>Jar D Daisy Jar</b>
Basic jar shape <b>D-9</b>	Cut 1 3/4" off of basic jar template	regular shape	regular shape	Cut 1" off of basic jar template
Extras	<u>Bias Strip Lid:</u> 1/2" wide by width of jar (with overhang) <u>Label D-6:</u> embroider with Jam and stitches <u>Bluebird</u> (see next)	<u>Flags:</u> <b>D-7</b> Make 2 flags out of two colors. I interfaced my lightest one so no see-through. <u>Stems:</u> Cut 5/8" wide, and run through 1/4" maker. <u>Heart:</u> <b>D-27</b>	<u>Lid:</u> <b>D-12</b> Embroider on tie. <u>Label D-6:</u> embroider with Honey and stitches	<u>Trim:</u> finished width is 1", and width of jar. <u>Stem:</u> Cut 5/8" wide, and run through 1/4" maker. Press curve into stem. <u>Daisy:</u> <b>D-26</b> <u>Center:</u> small circle



I made a few changes. I embroidered "Chocolate" and changed the bird's feet/beak.

Other Helps for Mason Jars: The pattern pieces from her kit all laid out.  
Go to Fat Quarter Shop to get everything you need.



### Bluebird Block -- make TWO



Bluebird	
Cut background 5" (will be trimmed to 4 1/2")	
Use <b>D-5 (wing)</b> and <b>D-17 (bird)</b> .	Trace off beak and feet from the Guide.

Placement: Center the bird (she gives no instructions).
