Basic Instructions:

Using block templates on final page, and paying attention to the Block Key, make 36 blocks. True up each block to 7 1/2" then arrange them alternately, so pinwheels form in the corners. Quilt as desired, then bind.

Even though those blues all look the same (and some are), vary your tones to have some differences between the blocks.

Pinwheel Quilt



This version is five blocks by five blocks, so it finishes at 45" square, a perfect size for a small quilt for babies or who need a size just to fit on a lap, and no more.

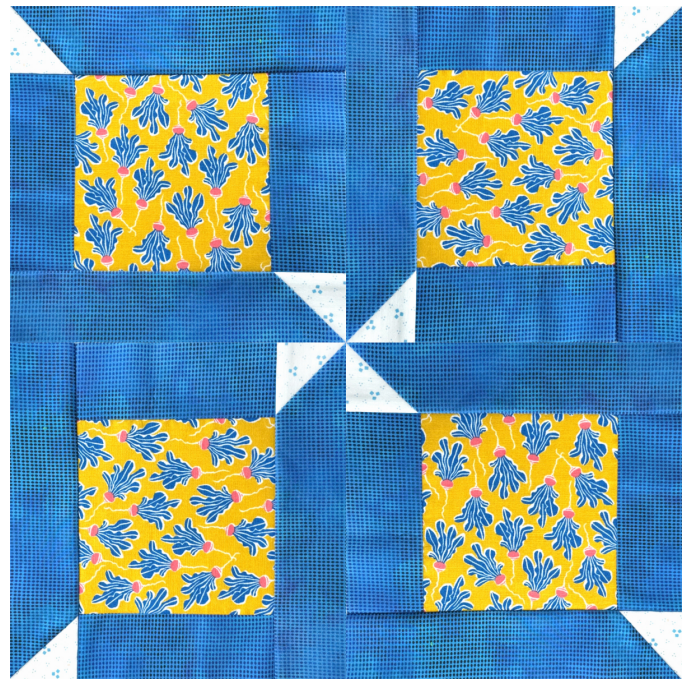

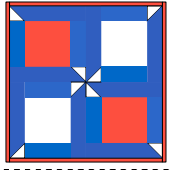

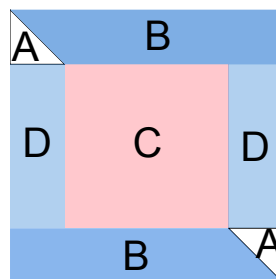
