Borders

Inner Border

Instructions are on page 4 of her BeeHappySewAlongGuide, but they are cut 2 1/2" wide, with four cornerstones

Hexie Middle Border

Use D-10 small hexie shape (1" hexie)

Use D-11 larger hexie shape (1 3/4" hexie)

Cut 68 -- 4" print squares for the large honeycomb shapes

Cut 32 -- 2-1/2" solid squares for the small honeycomb shapes

Cut 4 -- 4 1/2" cornerstones

Embroidery can be added to the solid small honeycomb shapes (a running stitch around the edges).

Backgrounds

The strips of honeycombs are not edge to edge around the quilt. There are breaks, according to the length of each background strip.

Cutting instructions for backgrounds:

- 1. FOUR blocks 4 1/2" by 4 1/2" They each have <u>one</u> large hexie shape (refer to Lori Holt's blog for placement and type). Two smaller hexie shapes go on top.
- 2. FOUR strips -- 4 1/2" by 10 1/2" They each have **three** hexie shapes (refer to her blog for placement and type). You'll be placing the multiples of hexies right next to each other when you sew them down to their strips.
- 3. TWO strips 4 1/2" by 16 1/2" They each have <u>five</u> hexie shapes (refer to her blog for placement and type).
- 4. TWO strips 4 1/2" by 20 1/2" They each have <u>six</u> hexie shapes (refer to her blog for placement and type).
- 5. TWO strips 4 1/2" by 22 1/2" They each have **seven** hexie shapes (refer to her blog for placement and type).
- 6. TWO strips 4 1/2" by 26 1/2" They each have <u>eight</u> hexie shapes (refer to her blog for placement and type).

Outer Border

Instructions are on page 4 of her BeeHappySewAlongGuide. She sandwiched in some large rick-rack between the binding and the finishing quilt.

Finished dimension: 72" x 80"


