

Bee Happy Sew Along -- Week 8 -- **Flower Box, Beehive****ALL PATTERNS & PHOTOS BY LORI HOLT****(ROW FIVE)**

<b>Background</b>	<b>Flowerbox</b>	<b>Daisies</b>	<b>Tulip</b>
10 1/2" wide by 12 1/2" tall (cut one)	D-29 Cut one  Cut one strip, cut 1 1/4" wide, run through the 3/4" bias tape maker (18mm) It should finish about 2" wider than box	D-26 --Cut two D-5 Cut four (leaves) D-1 Cut two (center circles)  Green stems are run through the 1/4" or 3/8" bias tape maker (your choice) Cut 1 stem approximately 3" long, the second stem about 4"	D-23 (cut one) D- 20 (cut one)  Green stem is run through the 1/4" or 3/8" bias tape maker (your choice); cut about 6" long.

**Placement and Steps:**

1. Press block in half lengthwise to help in arranging pieces. Near as I can tell, she placed the tip of the tulip 3/4" down from top, and the base of the flower box 3/4" up from the bottom.
2. She cut the top strip of the flower box 1/2" wider on each side, tucked in the raw edges and pinned it down.
3. Insert the flower stem before stitching the flower box; see boxes above for stem lengths (all three are different).
2. Appliqué the pieces, complete the embroidery around centers of flowers.

## Beehive Block



(ROW FOUR)

Background	Beehive	Heart/Door	Flowers
8 1/2" by 10 1/2" rectangle.	<b>D-32</b>  Placement: place even with lower edge, centered. You can press a fold into the block to use for alignment	Make door by using <b>D-22</b> , and cutting 2 1/2" off the bottom (from the sewn line). Align lower edge with bottom of hive. Use <b>D-27</b> for heart shape.	<b>D-1</b> center, or use Perfect Circles templates (cut two) <b>D-29</b> for flowers (cut two) <b>D-5</b> for leaves (cut four) Green stems are run through the 1/4" or 3/8" bias tape maker (your choice) I cut mine 10" and steamed in the bend at the top.

1. Do not add a 1/4 or turn under on the bottom of D-32 beehive and D-22 door. Center onto background, aligning lower raw edges with edge of block.

2. Place the flowers 3/4" in from the top and sides of background block.



3. Place bottom of stem 1" in from edge of the beehive (*upper right photo*).

4. Sew bee, bluebird, row of apples and beehive blocks together to finish off Row Four ----->
