



Heart (revised)

The inner background on this might not be red, but please keep that color in mind when choosing your strips that go around the outside.



MAKE ONE 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" block

1/4" seam allowance

Heart background, shown in grey

A Cut four 1" x 1"

B Cut two 2 1/4" x 2 1/4"

Heart

C Cut two 2 1/4" x 4"

(they may be two different fabrics)

Stash logs (each may be different, or mixed)

D cut one 1" x 4"

E cut one 1" x 4 1/2"

F cut one 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"

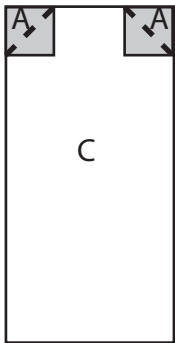
G cut one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

H cut one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

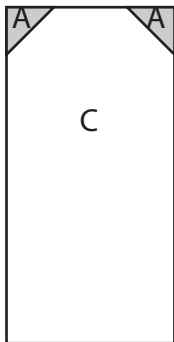
I cut one 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Stitch and flip method

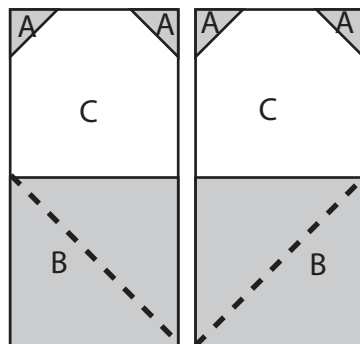
1. Place one A at each upper corner of C right sides together, mark diagonal line and stitch



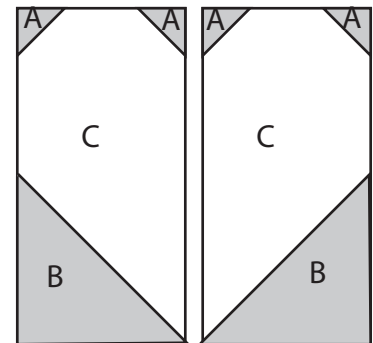
2. Press flat, then press towards heart trim excess on back side, repeat on other C



3. Place one B at the bottom of both Cs right sides together; mark diagonal lines as shown and stitch



4. Press flat, then press towards heart trim excess on backside,



5. Sew the two sections of heart matching seams, press flat then press seam open
Your heart should measure 4" x 4"

6. Sew D to ABC, stitch with ABC on top so you can easily see the bottom intersection of the heart
Press flat, then press towards D

7. Sew E to ABCD, stitch with ABCD on top to keep seams flat, press flat, then press towards E

8. Repeat stitching and pressing as instructed with F, then G, then H, then I
