


Scrappy Pinwheels

1/4" seam allowance




Make 2 sets of five pinwheels, using this or other favorite method. Basic pinwheel block will measure 3 1/2" w/ seam allowances.


- 1. Cut 5 different light strips, 2 1/2" x 11"
- Cut 5 different medium to dark strips, 2 1/2" x 11"
- 2. Pair one light strip with one medium to dark strip, right sides together (You will have 5 pairs)
- 3. On wrong side of the lightest strip, draw lines with pencil every 2 1/2" going the short direction Then draw diagonal lines as shown.




4. Sew 1/4" on both sides of drawn diagonal lines.




- 5. Cut on drawn vertical and diagonal lines
- 6. Press towards the darkSquare up each unit to 2" x 2"You should have 8 units for each pair of fabrics
- 7. Layout pinwheel sets
 - Sew two together, press towards the dark




Sew two together, press towards the dark





8. Complete the unit by sewing the two rows matching the center



- 9. If you remove the stitches in the seam in the very center, the center fans out. You can press the seam, one to one side and the other to the other side, making the center flat. You should have ten 3 1/2" pinwheel blocks.
- 10. Sew two sets of five pinwheels.
