## Bird's Eye View 5 ½" block

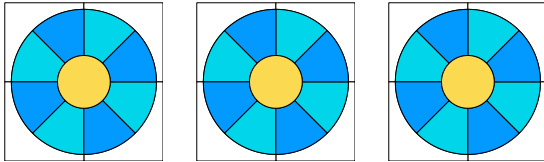

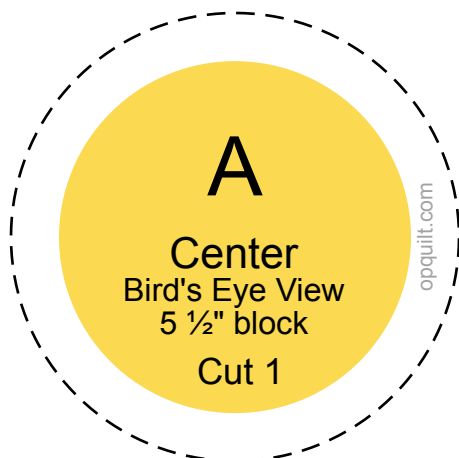
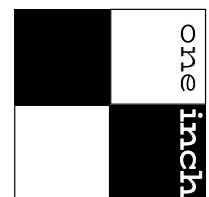


Construct the two-color wheel (**Rays B**), using paper foundation piecing, or freezer paper piecing. Sew the four **Rays B** pieces together. Using a plastic circle template, lightly spray the outer edges with spray starch, and iron the seam allowances to the wrong side, up over the template. This will make it easier for appliqué.

Cut a piece of background fabric 6½" square. Sew the four **Rays B** pieces together and appliqué this to the background circle.

Prepare the center circle using your favorite method. Center the **A** piece on your circle of rays, centering it. Pin, then appliqué the center into place.

Press block on an padded surface. Trim the block to 6" square.
