


## Stay-at-Home Round Robin•2026



# Orange Peels



In this round, I did a variation of orange peel, placing the peels along the lower border and on the left border. Illustration to left shows the plan.


This is built on a 3 ¾" base, so if you need to attach it to something that isn't divisible by that, add a coping strip to your existing quilt. Or use the 3.5" piece, with a 4" background block.

Cut 21 4 ¼" squares out of low-volume fabrics. Prepare the shapes, then appliqué using your favorite method. Sew in two rows, one of 10 patches, one of 11. Attach to quilt.



**3.5"**  
Cut 21 pieces  
Value scale 1-11

This piece does not have a seam allowance. Add it for turned edge appliqué.



**3.75"**  
Cut 21 pieces  
Value scale 1-11

I used an 11-step value scale, moving from purple at the outer edges to a bright red on the lower left corner, balancing the existing quilt top.
